The end of year is looming fast!

Just a few gentle reminders about student welfare and DET requirements, a few things have happened recently that need to be clarified again.

Absentees: Notes need to be sent in with your child once he/she resumes classes. If a note does not arrive your child will be marked as *absent with out leave (A)*. Also there have been a few absences that are not considered valid e.g. slept in and missed the bus and suffering sunburn from weekend activities. These will be marked as 'A'

Continual absences for recurring unspecified illnesses which upon return to school show no obvious symptoms. These would be considered by the Home School Liaison Office (HSLO) as grounds for a welfare check as students suffering recurring illnesses should be seen by their local doctor.

School arrival and finishing times: Please ensure your child/children arrive at school no later that 8.45am each day. This gives them time to settle in before class begins.

Most days we finish school at 3.00pm except when we have AASC which concludes at 3.30pm. Students who walk or get picked up by parents need to leave the school grounds at the finishing times. Only students who catch the bus are to remain on school grounds until the bus arrives.

If for some reason your child needs to stay at school a little longer or you are delayed, you need to ring the school and let them know or write a note and send it in with your child, we do not accept a verbal message from students. Also if someone else is picking up your child, ring the school before hand and supply the name of the person.

Visitors to the school (this includes relatives of students) are to come through the gate and report to the office. We do not want students thinking it is alright to go and talk to people at the various boundaries around the school grounds. These are certainly child protection issues. Our aim is to keep your children safe, please ensure that you inform the school of any changes to normal routines.

Presentation Night requirements

Each child needs to wear their school uniform (clean shirt with emblem preferably) for the more formal part of the evening . A colourful T shirt is required for one item , so please ensure if your child has not brought their costume in that they do so next week.

Raffle tickets and 100's club. The P&C are running a Christmas Hamper Raffle as well as a 100's club board. So make sure you sell your tickets and pick your lucky number. The numbers are for adults to purchase only, we will not accept money from students unless an adult informs us first.
